High Quality Education

Bowning Public School is a small school located in the village of Bowning. The caring small school environment provides unique, rich learning experiences for all students from Kindergarten to Year 6. The small school atmosphere creates a sense of belonging and connectedness for our students, parents, teachers and wider community. We have highly qualified staff that continue to grow their expertise by keeping up with new and evolving teaching methods and strategies.

Literacy

Our school participates in the *Early Action For Success* program and as a result has attracted additional training and teacher funding. We deliver L3 (Literacy, Language and Learning) in our K-2 classroom to support and extend the literacy levels of all students in the class. We focus on quality teaching instruction and feedback to students to create a culture of continuous improvement and success.



Technology

The students have a technology rich school with the integration of iPads and laptop computers into everyday lessons. This level of technology enables

individualisation of learning programs, while creating an engaging and fun learning environment.

Extra Curricula

Bowning Public School is a proud member of the Burrinjuck and Binit Binit Learning Communities. This relationship with a number of schools in our region allows our students to participate in a wide range of sporting endeavours and learning opportunities. Each term students join with other schools to learn and compete in sports such as; athletics, swimming, T-ball, touch football, netball, cricket, tennis and gymnastics.



The outcomes for student learning are also greatly increased with the linking of students in each grade with their peers in other schools for debating and public speaking and weekly combined teaching and learning in English and Mathematics.

Learning Environment

Our school is set in a spacious country setting with plenty of room for students to learn, play and develop. We have modern classrooms that are heated and cooled with reverse cycle air conditioners, which keeps our students comfortable and allows them to focus on their learning.

Out in our spacious play ground, we have a plant propagating area where we work with *Landcare* to provide native shrubs and trees to local areas for regeneration. We are continuing to grow this relationship, as students learn sus-

tainable ways to grow their own vegetables and herbs that are then used to cook healthy, innovative meals.
