

K-2 Learning




We have been learning about sentences and what parts we need to make a sentence. Ask your child if they can tell you. Hopefully they will say that it must make sense, have a subject, a verb, a capital letter and either a full stop, exclamation or question mark.

We have been looking at length this week and had fun measuring the length of our feet. We are also looking at number bonds, bundles of ten to organise our count and number lines. Year 1 and two learnt some new math games called Beat That and Salute. Ask your child to show you how they play.



Kindergarten are working on the letters and sounds m, n, d, o, g, e, r and have started to construct their own writing using the sounds and words they know.
